Testing Notes

•Sight:	Oriental and Mexican cuisine, dishes with citrus, fruity, and floral sauces.
•Nose:	It stands out with aromas of tropical and exotic fruits such as soursop, lychee, and passion fruit, citrus aromas like lime and grapefruit, and white flowers like jasmine.
•Palate:	It confirms the aromas of fruits and flowers, it is unctuous, with pleasant and fresh acidity, and a slightly bitter finish.
