•Serving temperature:	14° - 16° C
•Pairing:	Red meats grilled, charbroiled, or roasted with prolonged cooking, some aged and/or smoked cheeses.
Testing Notes	
•Sight:	Ruby red color with violet tones, clean and bright.
•Nose:	Floral aromas, ripe red fruits, and a background of spicy notes.
•Palate:	Its tannins are mature and provide smoothness that contrasts with its complexity.
