Testing Notes	
•Sight:	Intense plum red color, clean, bright, with a violet edge.
•Nose:	Of great aromatic intensity of red fruits and herbal touch, as the temperature rises, aromas of chocolate and vanilla appear.
•Palate:	Very pleasant on the palate, intense, fruity, complex, and balanced.
