• Varietal:	Cabernet sauvignon 50% Merlot 30% Petite Verdot 10% Malbec 10%
• Varietal Origin:	Bordeaux France

• Vineyard age:	30 years
• Wine making process:	Alcoholic fermentation by varietal, at controlled temperature and subsequent malolactic fermentation.
• Barrel:	American origin

• Pairing:	Grilled Fatty Cuts, Smoked, Braised and Slow-cooked; intensely spiced sauces with smoky notes and intense herbal notes. Matured and Aged Cheeses.

### Testing Notes

• Sight:	Intense violet-red color, with a slightly brownish edge.
• Nose:	A complex wine with aromas of ripe red and black fruits, spices, notes of wood, and leather.
• Palate:	A robust wine with intense body, meaty, and complex; it confirms the spicy and smoky aromas, it is long and elegant on the palate.
